**Agricultural Machines** 

Budget: Rs 2,000 Cr

• AMSS (Agricultural Machines Support Scheme)

A 15% subsidy will be provided for purchasing manufacturing machines and equipment.

Budget: Rs. 1,000 Cr

AMGY (Agricultural Machine Gyan Yojna)

Workshops for developing high-quality, low-cost agricultural machines will be conducted across the country.

Budget: Rs. 200 Cr

• AMIMY (Agricultural Machines Investment Madad Yojna)

A large exhibition will be held, and the government will provide funding to 100 enterprises. Other investors will also have the opportunity to invest in those enterprises.

Budget: Rs. 800 Cr

Loan with Less Documentation

Budget: Rs. 3,000 Cr

ALY (Aasan Loan Yojna)

Many micro and rural enterprises do not have most of the required documents for obtaining loans. Under this scheme, registered individuals can obtain a loan of up to 10 lakhs by presenting their requirements with just a few documents.

Budget: Rs. 2500 Cr

SVJHY (Sabka Vikas Jaruri Hai Yojna)

Committees will be established at the local level to help individuals obtain the required documents for loans, allowing more people to benefit from the Aasan Loan Yojna.

Budget: Rs. 500 Cr

Providing Low-Cost High-Quality Raw Materials

Budget: Rs. 5000 Cr

• SAARMS (Sasta Aur Achha Raw Material Scheme)

Under this scheme, registered enterprises will be connected directly to the government factory, reducing the cost of raw materials significantly.

Budget: Rs. 5000 Cr

Simplifying the Supply Chain

Budget: Rs. 2,000 Cr

GKSSVY (Government Ke Sath Se Vikas Yojna)

Small, medium, and micro enterprises often face challenges in selling their products on a large scale. Under this scheme, registered enterprises will be able to sell their products nationally and globally, in partnership with the government. The government will receive 5% profit for national-level sales and 10% for global sales.

Budget: Rs. 2,000 Cr

Rural Enterprises (Except Agricultural Machines)

Budget: Rs. 4,000 Cr

• HGABY (Har Gaon Aage Badhega Yojna)

A 20% subsidy will be provided to rural enterprises for purchasing equipment.

Budget: Rs. 2,000 Cr

• ETFRAS (Easy Transport for Rural Enterprises Scheme)

A 10% subsidy will be provided to rural enterprises for transportation.

Budget: Rs. 1,000 Cr

• HGAAY (Har Gaon Aage Aayega Yojna)

An annual rural enterprise exhibition will be held, providing opportunities for enterprises to find investors and for the government to invest in 500 enterprises.

Budget: Rs. 500 Cr

• KTRAS (Knowledge To Rural Areas Scheme)

Workshops will be conducted in every village to teach individuals about manufacturing high-quality products at low cost, and to provide guidance on the legal aspects of the process and how to take advantage of government schemes. Personal guidance will also be provided as needed.

Budget: Rs. 500 Cr

The government will establish an organization under the HGEBY (Har Ghar Ek Brand Yojna) to provide low-cost services for medium enterprises in urban and sub-urban areas (excluding agricultural machinery), with a budget of Rs. 2,000 Cr.

The government will also allocate a budget of Rs. 4,500 Cr for **textiles**. To upgrade machinery, a budget of Rs. 2,000 Cr has been set aside for the MITPS (Modernization In Textile Production Scheme), which will provide a 10% subsidy for purchasing modern equipment.

Additionally, the HQLCRMS (High Quality Low Cost Raw Materials Scheme) will provide high-quality low-cost raw materials from farmers and factories, with a budget of Rs. 1,500 Cr. Finally, the CAETFTS (Cheap And Easy Transport For Textiles Scheme) will provide a 5% subsidy for transporting textiles, with a budget of Rs. 1,000 Cr."
