

Ministry of women ~ Budget Dialogue, National Youth Parliament

For the ministry the largest budget allocation has been for the ICDS integrated child development services. We are allocating funds for spreading awareness and running campaigns to promote healthy and balanced diet to encourage families to feed their children nutritious food. The amount will be 21000 crores.

We propose 3500 crores through partnership with local organisations, we proposed to provide self defence training programs for women these programs will teach women's physical self defence techniques as well strategies for avoiding dangerous situations

A budget of 500 crores will be invested to create a mechanism that ensure that the pay for men and women are equal. These inspection will be conducted semi annually.

We propose 200 crore which will be used to appoint women psychologist in public healthcare centres and a additional 100 crore for women to seek legal help if required.

300 crores would given to nari udyamee yojna to support women to open their own businesses and become financially independent.

All the Anganwadi in the country would be provided with sanitary napkins which they can provide to the rural women at a low rate this will also help the startups which are producing eco friendly sanitary napkins a budget of 400 crore would be given.

Women's rights in Jammu and Kashmir is a major issue. Belonging to a patriarchal society, they have had to fight inequality and routine discrimination.
